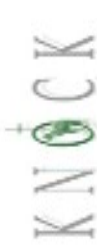
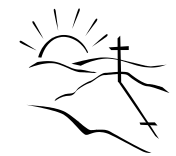
Next weekend we welcome Fr Brian Johnson OSF who will speak at some Masses in the parish.

Do you wish your child to receive First Communion & Confirmation in 2011?

Parents / guardians of children attending schools not under the patronage of the Bishop of Meath are informed that if they wish their children to receive the sacraments of First Penance, First Holy Communion and Confirmation in 2011, they must enrol their children in the Parish Catechetical Programme. Preparation begins once the schools re-open. Please make an application in writing to the Administrator, Cathedral House, before **Friday 24 September**. Applications received once tuition begins will have to wait until the next school year. A qualified teacher will prepare the children.
