## WW II Saints ..... The Church remembers 2 saints from World War II at Masses this week

**Monday**  
**St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross (Edith Stein)**  
Edith Stein was a brilliant student, who gained a doctorate in philosophy at twenty-five. She became a Catholic in 1922 and a Carmelite Nun. Both Jewish & Catholic, she fled to Holland when the Nazis came to power but she was captured and sent to Auschwitz where she died in its gas chamber on 9 August 1942.

**Saturday**  
**St Maximilian Kolbe 1894-1941**  
Maximilian was a Franciscan priest who published newspapers in Poland. He was arrested during the War for helping 2,000 Jews find refuge and practising as a priest. When he saw a young man about to be executed in the Auschwitz camp he stepped forward to give his life so that the younger man might live and eventually get home to his wife and children.

 Parents / guardians of children attending schools not under the patronage of the Bishop of Meath are informed that if they wish their children to receive the sacraments of First Penance, First Holy Communion and Confirmation in 2011, they must enrol their children in the Parish Catechetical Programme. Preparation begins once the schools re-open. Please make an application in writing to the Administrator, Cathedral House, before **Friday 24 September**. Applications received once tuition begins will have to wait until the next school year. A qualified teacher will prepare the children.
