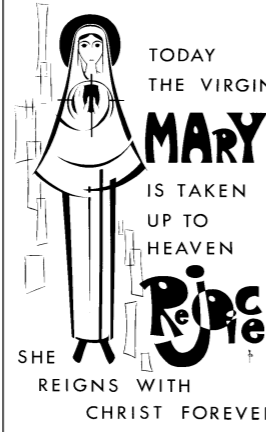

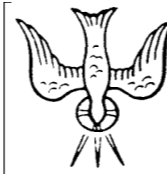

*Don't show off when you drive, drive safely and arrive.*

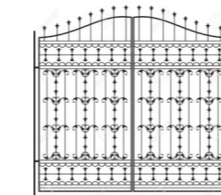
