Collection for Ukraine: Pope Francis has asked all parishes in Europe to make a collection in support of the Church in Ukraine next weekend, 24th April.

Pope Francis will visit Ukraine in late June, where the ongoing war has claimed over 10,000 lives leaving almost 2 million people displaced including 300,000 children. The collection will be taken as an exit collection in the Cathedral & St Paul's Church. Contributions for Ukraine can also be made to the Trócaire Box at the back of the Cathedral between Sunday 24th April—Sunday 1st May.

The Icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help



The Redemptorists in Ireland together with all of 26 Catholic Cathedrals will celebrate the 150th anniversary of devoition to the 'Mother of Perpetual Help. An Icon blessed by Pope Francis will be taken to all Cathedrals as part of the anniversary pilgrimage.

Blessed Pope Pius IX presented the Icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help to the Redemptorists for veneration in their newly-built Church of Sant'Alfonso in December 1865. The Holy Father gave the Redemptorists a mandate: they were to promote devotion to Our Lady of Perpetual Help throughout the world. Just over a year later, the first copy of the icon arrived in Ireland.

The Icon will visit Mullingar Cathedral arriving on Tuesday 26th April and departing on Wednesday 27th April.
