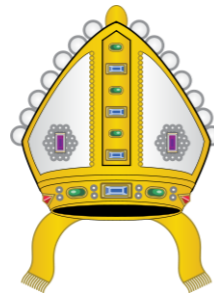

## Welcome and prayerful best wishes to our new Bishop



On Monday last, Pope Francis named **Canon Thomas Deenihan**, as the new Bishop of Meath, succeeding Bishop Michael Smith.

Bishop-Elect Thomas Deenihan was born in Blackpool, Cork, in June 1967. He carried out his theological studies at the Saint Patrick's College, Maynooth. He subsequently obtained a doctorate in education from the University of Hull, England, in 2003.

He was ordained a priest for the diocese of Cork & Ross on 1st June 1991. After ordination he served in the parishes of Glanmire, Schull, Kealkill and Bantry. Since 2006 he has served as Diocesan Secretary in Cork & Ross.

Our new Bishop has extensive experience in the area of Catholic Education, having served as Diocesan Secretary for Education and in other roles such as General Secretary of Catholic Primary Schools Management Association and as Acting Executive Secretary of the Council for Education and the Commission for Catholic Education and Formation of the Irish Bishops' Conference.

Bishop-Elect Thomas Deenihan will be ordained as Bishop of Meath in Mullingar Cathedral on Sunday 2nd September.
